## **District Overview**

Shravasti is one of the district of Uttar Pradesh curved from district bahraich on 22-05-1997. It is aapproximately 175 kilometers away from the uttar pradesh state capital, Lucknow. District Shares border with Nepal country. Shravasti is a historically famous district of eastern Uttar Pradesh.

It is closely associated with the life of Lord Buddha. It is one of the main site for Buddhist pilgrimage as well and Jain Pilgrimage.

According to hindu mythology a famous Historical temple Seeta Dwar of Shravasti is known as birth place of Luv and Kush, the son of Bhagawan Sri Ram. Apart from That a historical temple Vibhuti Nath of Bhagawan Shiv from mahabharat era is situated in dense suhelwa range forest also known as Gupt Kashi, It is believed that this Shivling was established by the Pandavas during their exile.

## **Present Status**

The district has an area of 2458 Sq.Kms having 3 tehsils, 5 blocks and 536 inhabited villages. Main river is River Rapti. The projected population 2022 is 1305062 and the district is predominantly rural in nature.

Shravasti district curved from district Bahraich on 22-05-1997, which was very poor on various developments sectors. The key backward areas of the district were Health, Nutrition, Education, Agriculture, economic growth, employment, infrastructure, transportation and communication. Apart from that almost every year affected flood in river Rapti causes loss of life, wealth, infrastructure along backwardness of the district, which affects the development of the district.

According to the vision of the Hon Prime Minister of the country, Shri Narendra Modi Ji, district is given opportunity under aspirational district program running on 112 districts all over India. The district is moving fast on various parameters of development and many achievements have been achieved in the field of development in the district. The Aspirational Districts Programme (ADP) aims to quickly and effectively transform under-developed districts. This program focuses on the strength of district, identifying low-hanging fruits for immediate improvement and measuring progress by ranking districts on a monthly basis.

Focus is given for incremental progress made across 49 Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) under 5 broad socio-economic themes - Health & Nutrition, Education, Agriculture & Water Resources, Financial Inclusion & Skill Development and Basic Infrastructure.

The district was very backward in health and Nutrition services earlier, but after continuous improvements in health services, presently there are 01 Combined district hospital, 07 CHCs, 11 PHCs, 125 sub-centers (106 health and wellness centers) and 925 Anganwadi centers that are having acute shortage of staff, doctors, specialists etc. Shravasti is an international tourist place and is a border district of Nepal, so foreign patients also travel from here.

- > Strengthen Anganwadi centers for nutrition management at gross root level.

- ➤ Online monitoring system for patients and medicine tracking.
- ➤ Third party evaluation system for performance analysis.

Status of Education was not so good earlier, but after continuous improvements in education services, presently there are 984 Primary and UPS schools, 124 madhyamic colleges and 10 degree colleges and 2 polytechnic and 4 ITI are available. There are huge shortage of staff in these institutions. With the help of CSR, smart classes in 335 schools are functional. For development of district education services needs to be improved.
